

# Frequently Requested Data Points


---

- Graduation rates
- Number of graduates
- Retention rates
- Demographics (gender and/or ethnicity)
- Number of majors enrolled
- Number of new students recruited/enrolled

# Effective Data Reporting

---

- Be specific!
  - Who (“Undergraduate Hispanic women in Mechanical Engineering”)
  - When (“Fall semesters from Fall 2016-Fall 2020”)
  - Why
- Provide context; How do you compare to:
  - Other similar programs at UNM?
  - UNM as a whole?
  - Programs at peer institutions?
  - Population?




